Event Overview

Stall Fees

- **\$40 per stall, without power**
- **\$80 per stall, with power**

Stall Holder Requirements

All stall holders must provide:

- Current Public Liability Insurance.
- Current Food Handling Certificate where applicable.
- Current Liquor Licence where applicable.

Food and beverage stall holders must comply with all relevant NSW food safety requirements, including any required food handling documentation, safe preparation practices, and appropriate storage and display of food and beverages.

Venue Conditions

To protect Memorial Hall, stall holders must comply with the following:

- No items are to be attached to the walls.
- All signage and displays must be free-standing.

- No scuff marks, scratches, or damage are to be made to the floor.
- Stall holders are responsible for leaving their site clean and tidy.

Load In and Out

Bump In will commence from **6:00am on Sunday 4 October 2026**. All stall holders must be fully set up and ready for trade before the event opens.

Bump Out will commence after **4:00pm**, once the event has closed and it is safe to begin pack-down. Vehicles must be removed from the immediate event area once unloading is complete.

Stall holders are responsible for leaving their site clean, tidy, and free of rubbish. Set-up must be completed in time for the event opening.

Equipment and Presentation

Tables and chairs will be provided by the organiser. Stall holders should bring their own display, banners, equipment, signage, extension leads where required, and any additional items needed for their stall.

Kitchen Use

An Expression of Interest is invited from stall holders seeking use of the kitchen. Stall holders wishing to use the kitchen must indicate this in their application or contact the event organiser for further information.

Payment Details

Stall fees are payable by **1 October 2026**. An invoice will be sent to the email address provided in the stall holder application. Your booking will be confirmed once payment has been received and processed.
